“A hobby gone wild” . . . . Shannon Fry

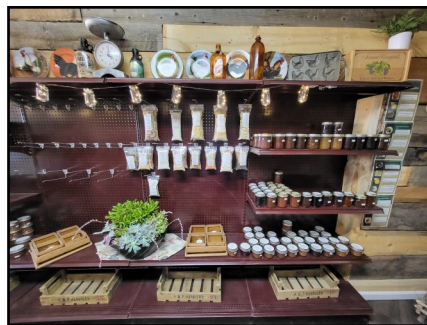


After almost a year of planning and working on the restaurant, Shannon and Jeff Fry celebrated the Grand Opening of The Root Cellar on July 4 and 5. While Shannon did the menu planning, cooking, purchasing supplies and canning, Jeff did the build out of the interior, transforming the old post office into a charming and quaint eatery.

Shannon and Jeff are not new to the restaurant business, as they owned a deli in Kingman before moving to the Meadview area. Shannon also cooked for the Kingman Academy and they operated hot and cold food trucks. When the Fry’s moved Meadview, they established Nestrin Farmhouse and started selling fresh eggs. Shannon has been a familiar face at all of Meadview’s events and Farmer’s Markets where they sold fresh eggs and homemade food products.

Some of you also know of Shannon from her Karaoke performances at the Barn where she has been an audience favorite. Editor Note: Shannon’s rendition of the classic “Me and Bobby McGee” is a personal favorite.

Cooking and canning started as a “hobby” for family and friends and then expanded to a cottage license business. But now Shannon calls it her “hobby gone wild”. When Sandy and Al Pompa offered the old post office space to Shannon and Jeff, the opportunity to take her cooking skills to a new level was born. Shannon has a talent for putting a twist on classic food favorites such as pizza to create healthy and nutritious versions. The menu features dishes from Shannon’s Norwegian heritage. Customers are treated to healthy Kombucha beverages, “Lefse” wraps and appetizers. The wraps are not just offered as an entrée, but there are some delicious dessert wraps with ingredients such as dark chocolate, roasted pecans and fresh fruit. All menu items are made fresh daily.



The Root Cellar is open Monday, Tuesday, Friday and Saturday from 11:00 am—3:00 pm. There is limited seating, and currently, it is mostly “take-out” with in store pick-up and shopping for homemade goods. They do have plans to offer more seating for in house dining. ## COUNTY CORNER

As your Mohave County Treasurer, I would like to address a concern that primarily affects our new home buyers.

Mohave County property tax bills are based on a calendar year (January 1 - December 31) with the first installment due October 1. Taxes may be paid in two installments if the bill exceeds \$100. The first installment is due October 1 and delinquent November 1. The second installment is due March 1 and delinquent May 1. Tax bills less than \$100 are delinquent if not paid by December 31.

The Treasurer's office receives an electronic file from the Assessor's office in early August of each year that contains the property valuation, classification and the owners' mailing address. There is a mid-July cut-off for address/owner updates so the data file can be completed by the Assessor and submitted to the Treasurer's office in a timely manner. Depending on the volume of real estate transactions, this can mean that new property owners who closed their purchase in June or later may not receive the September tax statement. If the taxes were not paid through escrow, then they will become delinquent in November and the first notice the new property owner receives is the June delinquency notice. Unfortunately, that means the bill is delinquent and interest and fees are levied against the account. **ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES DO NOT GIVE THE TREASURER LEGAL AUTHORITY TO WAIVE THE FEES, PENALTIES OR INTEREST.** This affects less than 1% of our new home buyers but everyone should be aware.

If you do not receive a property tax statement in late September, please visit our website for an electronic copy and submit your payment prior to the delinquent deadline to avoid assessment of delinquent fees and interest. **Property owners (new and old) can check to verify their tax bill has been paid by using the Treasurer's website [mohave.gov](http://mohave.gov) or by calling our office at 928-753-0737.**

The Treasurer's office is open from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday. Property taxes can be paid online, by mail, in-person at Kingman's Mohave County Administration building or by phone by calling *Point & Pay* at (855) 814-6451. The All-Star Game was first played in 1933. The first game was held in Chicago's Comiskey Park to boost morale during the Great Depression. It was also part of the World's Fair. The first home run was hit by Babe Ruth.

The American League has won the most games with 48 games. The National League won in 2025 with the first time ever swing-off after a 9th inning 6-6 tie.

Hank Aaron had a record of 25 selections in his 23-year career. Confused? Between 1959 and 1962, MLB had two All-Star Games each season. Willie Mays and Stan Musial played in 24 games. And Willie Mays has the most hits in All-Star Game history with 23 and most plate appearances with 82.

Yankee manager Casey Stengel managed the most All-Star games with 10.

The MVP award was started in 1962. Maury Wills was the first named MVP. Derek Jeter is the only player to be an All-Star and World Series MVP in the same year: 2000. Five players have been named MVP twice: Willie Mays, Steve Garvey, Gary Carter, Cal Ripken Jr. and Mike Trout.

The Detroit Tigers who hold the best record in MLB today had the most players in the 2025 All-Star Game with six.

The 2026 All-Star Game will be played in Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.



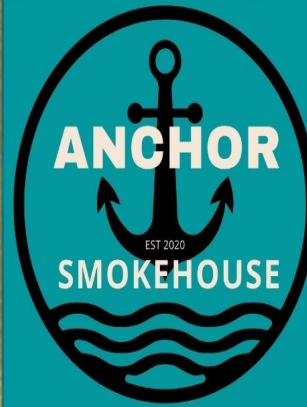
