## SPOTLIGHT ON "MORE TO MEAD"

The construction of Hoover Dam and the Lake Mead reservoir was for flood control of the Colorado River and to generate electric power. The bonus of this project was the recreational use of the lake for water sports such as fishing and boating. Management of Hoover Dam and Lake Mead operations are done by the Bureau of Reclamation. Management of the national park area is performed by the Lake Mead National Recreation Area of the National Park Service. Both entities are part of the Department of Interior.

When the lake levels started dropping significantly, staff of LMNRA became concerned about the future of the recreational aspect of the lake and surrounding area. They felt it was critical to explore other uses of the park besides motorized watercraft. That was when they created the "More to Mead" program. They worked with COM to hold a town hall meeting July 24, 2024 to introduce the program to Meadview area residents and get input about what activities we would like to see developed. Additionally, meetings were held in Boulder City and Bullhead. They also created an on-line survey to gather more input. Budget cuts by the Federal Government restrict travel by government employees outside their workplace and they are limited to virtual meetings and press releases to distribute information.

The team used input from the survey and meetings to create a gameplan. One of the items mentioned was to organize litter control of Pierce Ferry from where LMNRA begins to the lake. With the help of volunteers from the Meadview area, there have been two cleanups of that stretch of highway. They have also come up with a "wish list" of interests of activities outside of motorized boating based on the input they received. The #1 activity of interest is Kayaking, Canoeing and/or Stand-up Paddleboarding. These activities were either the first or second choice out of 19 options.

Improvements that folks want are:

- Improved camping facilities or authorized primitive camping
- Swimming or other shore use including basic facilities like parking and restrooms
- Improved and easier access for kayak/SUP/canoe launch
- NPS/LMNRA involvement in existing and new area events and activities such as scheduled events, rental of non-motorized watercraft, concessions or other commercial services.
- Improved signage and off road trail maps.

There will be an on-line Quarterly Community Meeting on Wednesday August 21 at 9:00 am. Much has happened at the park over the past few months and Superintendent Mike Mike Gauthier is anxious to share updates. More to Mead is on the agenda. I will attend this meeting and will report on the information provided.

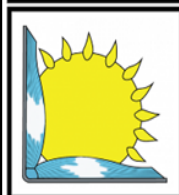

With 240 novels over the last four decades, Roberts has established herself as a popular romance writer. But did you know that she also writes police science fiction under the name J.D. Robb? Her first novel wasn’t published until 1981: *Irish Thoroughbred*. She often writes trilogies, finishing the three books in a row so that she can remain with the same characters. In both 1999 and 2000, four of the five novels listed as the best-selling romance novels of the year were written by Roberts.
