

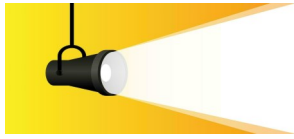

SPOTLIGHT ON THE MEADVIEW HISTORICAL SOCIETY

What started out as a vision and an idea in someone’s mind ended up becoming a reality. The vision was to preserve and document Meadview’s history and tell the stories of the people who built this little corner of the world. . The idea was to create a place where people could learn about the history, see artifacts from days gone by and read the stories. And because of the dedication and tenacious efforts of a handful of people, we now have a Meadview Historical Society and a museum for residents and visitors to enjoy.

After years of organizing and planning, the Meadview Historical Society has become a non-profit organization authorized to operate in compliance with the provisions of a 501C-3. The goal of the society is to preserve and share the history, culture and natural heritage of the Meadview region. This is accomplished through education, community involvement and protecting the stories, places and landscapes that make this area unique That includes not only the history of the town itself, but also the remarkable natural environment that surrounds us, including places like the Grapevine Mesa and the Joshua Tree Forest, which is one of the most unique landscapes in the Mojave Desert.



We want to send out a big “thank you” to Mike Martinez and John Strickland who generously provided the building that allows the Society to house and display many of Meadview’ historical items. Their support has made an enormous difference. The building has been provided to us free of charge—no rent, no utilities and no liability insurance costs. We recently created a reading area with chairs and books, so visitors can relax and read about the history rather than just walk through. The museum is open on Friday and Saturday from 11:00 am-2:00 pm.

An on-going project of the Historical Society is to recognize buildings in town that have been an important part in the history of Meadview. Interpretive panels have been designed that will designate these locations and include the history of the building. Watch for the announcement about the dedication of the first of these buildings, the Meadview Post Office.

We sponsor a movie night on the first Friday of each month at the Barn Event Center at 6:00 pm. Proceeds from the sale of snacks are donated to the historical society. We also have a raffle for some beautiful original artwork. Tickets can be purchased at the museum, post office, COM meetings and Farmer’s Market.

Thank you again for supporting the Meadview Historical Society. The museum truly belongs to the community and we appreciate everyone who helps keep the history of this special place alive. 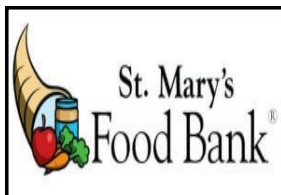

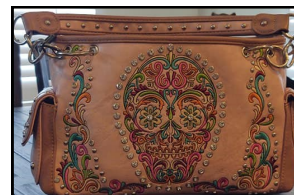
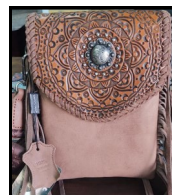
