



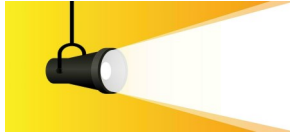

SPOTLIGHT ON THE HEAT WAVE AND VENOMOUS CRITTERS

The weather in March 2026 has definitely lived up to the “in like a lion” reputation. Every day weather records are being broken throughout the entire country. In the Midwest, we saw record breaking snowfalls and the Southeast has been hit with record low temperatures. At the same time, folks in Arizona are experiencing July-like temperatures in March. Towns all over Arizona have set new records for the earliest heat ever recorded in March. The little town of Matinez Lake near Yuma broke the record for the highest temperature ever recorded in March in the United States reaching 110 degrees on March 19. As the heat wave moves east from the southwest, it is causing more havoc in the Midwest with severe thunderstorms and tornados spreading from Missouri to Pennsylvania.



Arizona is not only breaking records for the heat, but also for an early rattlesnake and scorpion surge throughout the state. Venomous activity is spiking months early as the record March heat is driving rattlesnakes and scorpions out of dormancy and into residential areas and hiking trails. Snake bites have doubled compared to this time last year. The Banner Poison and Drug Information Center has already logged 237 scorpion sting calls for 2026. The season for bites and stings typically doesn’t begin until May, but the March heat has started things early.

During the winter months, when snake activity is rare, we become complacent about encountering a snake. However, we need to sharpen our awareness of snakes quickly when they emerge from their winter dens. Typically, this is when they are most active as they are on the hunt for food.

Take the time to research the habits of the venomous critters of the Meadview area. Be able to identify the difference between a “good” snake or a “bad” snake. Good snakes such as King or Bull Snakes are predators of rattlesnakes. When going out at night, always carry a flashlight. When daytime temperatures are high, the snakes will be more active at night. If you are a hiker, stay on maintained trails. Never put your hands in crevices or on surfaces you can’t see.

Snake Avoidance Training is returning to Meadview. Mackie Falkengren has once again offered her property as the location where this training will take place on April 17. Space is limited and training is by appointment only. See the ad on page 2 for more information. If you have a dog that has never received Snake Avoidance Training, it can be a life saver. Knowledge is the best defense. Know everything you can about snake and scorpion habits so you don’t become a victim.

During the training session, an e-collar is used. Training is conducted in a safe, controlled environment, ensuring the safety of your dog as well as the safety of the defanged rattlesnakes.

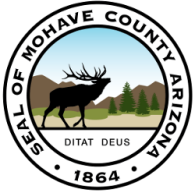

March Greetings from the Recorder's Office!

As we make our way into March, we're pleased to share some updates from the Recorder's Office. Our office remains committed to developing access of public records dating back to 1972 through our Historical Indexing Project. Which can be accessed on our public lobby computers at our main office.

The Recording Division continues to work diligently in providing accessibility to public records by manually indexing all documents. Our office recently implemented a verifying process to further ensure accuracy of indexes and improve retrievability of recorded documents. Residents can view, download, and print recorded documents through our online Recorded Document Search here: <https://eaglerss.mohave.gov/web/user/disclaimer>

Our Recorded Document Alert System recently marked its two-year anniversary! This system allows residents to receive email notifications when a document is recorded with their name or associated with their property. You can sign up for this free alert system here: <https://eaglerss.mohave.gov/web/fraudGuard/disclaimerPage>

The Recorder's Office continues to prioritize the residents of Mohave County through community outreach. We would like to encourage Veterans to take advantage of DD214 recording as this is a free service we provide to ensure safe-keeping. Voter Registration

The Voter Registration division is gearing up and excited for the upcoming election season! The Voter Registration Division manages several key responsibilities including: mailing early ballots to eligible voters, operating early voting locations and processing the early ballot returns. After performing signature verification, we securely transfer the ballots to the Elections Department for tabulation.

Important Dates to Note:

- April 1** New Voter ID Cards will be mailed to every active voter. This can be presented with a state issued driver's license/ID at voting locations.
- April 20** 90-Day Notices will be sent out to all active voters. This notice gives voters the opportunity to request or opt out of an early ballot, update their address, and review other important registration details prior to the election deadline.
- June 22** Last day to register to vote for the Primary Election.
- June 24** In person early voting begins.
- June 24** Early Ballots are mailed.
- July 10** Last day to request a mail in ballot for the Primary Election.
- July 17** Last day to vote early in person.
- July 21** Primary Election Day!

You can also visit the website www.my.arizona.vote anytime to request a ballot, check your voter registration or find your polling location.

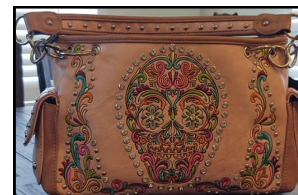
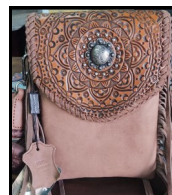
