

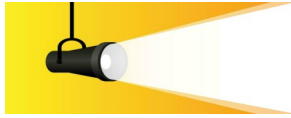

## SPOTLIGHT ON THE HISTORY OF FESTIVALS HELD IN MEADVIEW

Festivals and parades have always played a role in the history of Meadview. They have raised funds for large scale projects such as paving Meadview Boulevard, installing the Welcome to Meadview sign complex and establishing the Joy Trail. In 2011, the Meadview Area Chamber of Commerce decided Grand Marshals should be members of the Community selected based on merit and community service. They also established the tradition that the Grand Marshal of one year should select the Grand Marshal for the following year.

- 2011** Called the Spring Fling and held at the MCA. The Chamber selected Bill and Elaine Phebus to be Grand Marshals. Bill was a WWII bomber pilot and active in MESA, VFW and the MCA. Elaine was a member of MESA.
- 2012** Renamed Boat the Lake Festival in line with the Chamber's newly established logo "Boat the Lake, Hike the Canyon and Walk the Sky". Grand Marshals: Jack and Suzann Newell. Jack was president of the MCA, MESA And volunteer fire fighter. Suzann: President of Explorers, MESA, COM and Chamber Secretary.
- 2013** Moved to the Plaza, now Meadview Marketplace. Bob Brady and Lucille Sunde. Bob was Fire Chief and active in many organizations. Lucille was President of Quail and CFIC, COM VP and active in MESA.
- 2014** Gladys Burk: President of Quail, CFIC, MESA, COM and active in many organizations.
- 2015** Pastor John Mulvihill and Kathy: Pastor of Community Church and VFW Chaplain.
- 2016** Pastor Dale Kronomeyer and Mo: Pastor of Meadview Baptist Church. Mo was active in RW and B Quilters
- 2017** Frank and Lynda Eakins: Both active in VFW. Frank was MCA President. Together they started Meadview RidgeRiders. Linda was a member of the Auxiliary and a Gift Gallery member for many years.
- 2018** Bob and Brenda Porzio. The Porzios requested that AnnaMarie Shields be an Honorary Grand Marshal. Bob: Volunteer Firefighter, COM Treasurer and MCA maintenance. Brenda was Quail VP and active in Quilters
- 2019** Adrienne O'Keeffe: Chamber President, Gift Gallery Mgr, Quail Treasurer, COM Editor of Community News
- 2020** Cancelled due to COVID.
- 2021** Karen and Carl Stacy: Karen: Quail President, COM VP, Coordinator Litter Control. Carl: Volunteer Firefighter and COM board member. Both were active in MESA.
- 2022** Bob and Jeanne Hampton: Active VFW and Auxiliary members. Jeanne ran food distribution for years.
- 2023** Tom and Adrienne O'Keeffe: Tom: MCA President, Chamber Treasurer, COM Treasurer
- 2024** Sharon Baur: Founder of Friends of AZ Joshua Tree Forest and the Historical Society, MCA President and VP
- 2025** Renamed Meadview Spring Festival. Bill and Edie Needham. Bill: Chamber President, Edie: Chamber Secretary

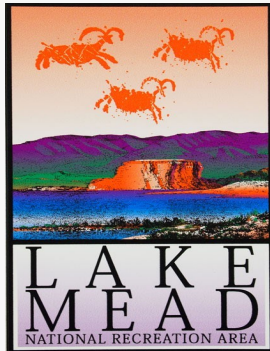

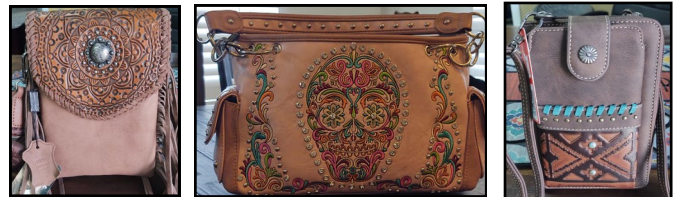
